


Device Restrictions at Diamond Peak

- As a general rule, ski and snowboard equipment with bindings is allowed for use at Diamond Peak. If there are not bindings, it is not allowed.
- If a device is being used as an accessibility device, it is approved for use.

Restricted Equipment




Allowed as an accessibility device only

Snow Skates



Skateboard with mini-snowboard attached to the bottom. No bindings, therefore not allowed.



Skateboard with slick surface on the bottom. No bindings, therefore not allowed.

Babies in Backpacks/Front Packs



Not allowed on lifts or ski runs. Children must have their own ski/snowboard equipment and sit on

the lift next to the parent.

Drones





Snowboard with no bindings, therefore not allowed.

Sleds



Sleds are not allowed at Diamond Peak at any time.
